Within this recommendation you are allowed to visit other CEPT-countries without applying a license in the visited country. On the website of the European Radio communication Office ([www.ero.dk](http://www.ero.dk)) you can find information about this recommendation and the countries who has been implemented this recommendation. Primary the recommendation T/R 61-01 is valid for licenses with a full advance to the amateur radio frequencies. Secondary there is also a possibility for the so called "novice-license".*

*If you are coming from a CEPT-country that has not been implemented the recommendation, or from a country not member of the CEPT, you can be granted a temporary license in the Netherlands for a period with a maximum of one year.*

***This application shall be accompanied by a certified copy of a valid amateur radio license in the home country.***
